The Lancet Commission examines the global response to the first 2 years of pandemic, citing failures across various aspects that accounted for an estimated 17.7 million deaths.

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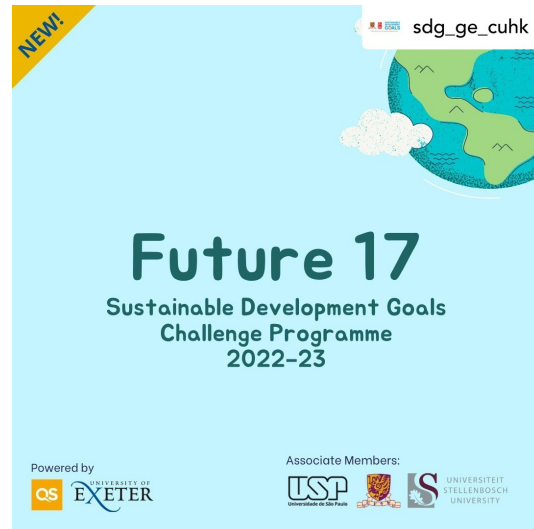
