The EPD's city-wide monthly campaign encourages the public to practise resource separation and recycling. A wide range of online and face-to-face activities are offered to engage citizens.

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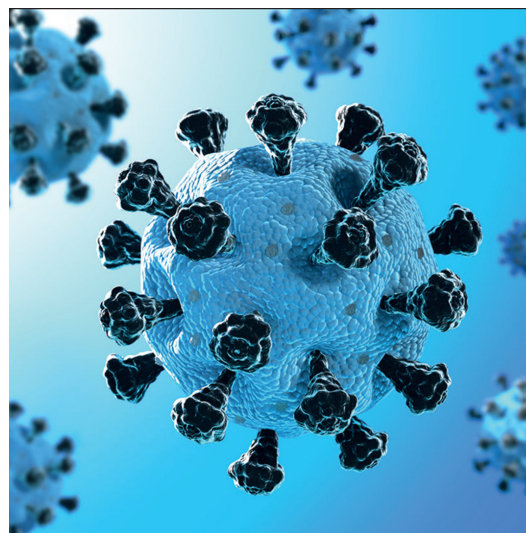
