This report focuses on the happiness and well-being of individuals at various stages of life, while delving into the unique challenges and opportunities faced by children, adolescents, and older adults.

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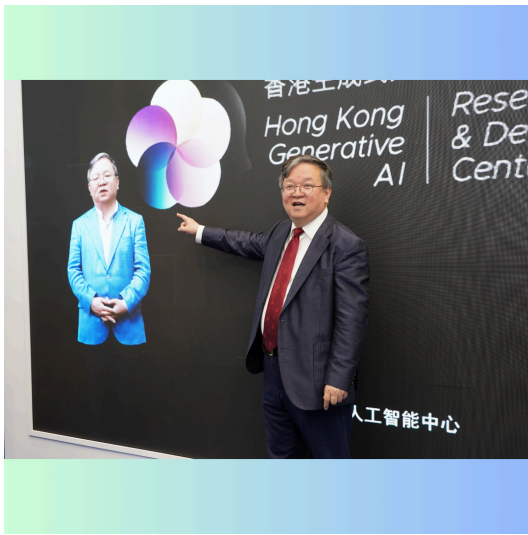


[Out Now] Localising the SDGs in a changing landscape
