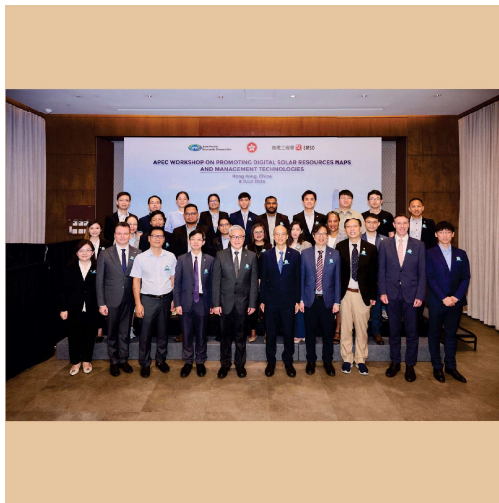
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Local Conference of Youth HK 2024– ‘Beyond 1.5°C: A Climate-Resilient Future for All’

Identification of Novel Gut Microbiome Biomarkers for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) Diagnosis

A CUHK Medicine research team has developed a highly accurate ASD diagnostic panel and found gut microbiome modulation alleviates anxiety in children with ASD, suggesting new therapeutic potential.

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Sustainable Solar Desalination Technology

A CityUHK research team has developed a hierarchical salt-rejection strategy that prevents precipitation in solar-powered seawater desalination systems. This strategy enables stable and efficient desalination, potentially providing affordable drinking water to water-stressed regions.

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
